

Thursday Night Mixed Bowling League
2010-2011 Season Rules

1. The league shall bowl at Champion Lanes starting September 9th, 2010 @ 6:30.
2. Each Team shall consist of four regular members, 2 men and 2 women. A team may bowl 3 women & 1 man or 3 men & 1 woman with the exception of position night & roll off. **Bowlers may use a combination of 3 women & 1 man or 3 men & 1 woman or a sub during position rounds provided their team is not in contention for first or second place. No pre-bowling will be allowed during these times.**
3. New bowlers entering the league will establish their average the first night after 3 games are bowled. All others use last year's average for the first 6 games bowled.
4. Weekly kitty fee will be \$2.75, bowling fee \$7.25 for total of \$10.00 per bowler.
5. Blind scores shall be 10% less than the highest bowler not bowling. Keep in mind a team consist of 2 men & 2 women. If a team is bowling with a blind score, the score sheet must reflect 2 men and 2 women's scores. A team not having enough bowlers on the roster will use 130 for both average & score. Two blinds on a four man team may be used.
6. A late bowler may bowl provided that the 4h frame of the first game is not completed. They must be present at the start of the 2nd & 3rd game.
7. All blinds must be paid in full, \$10.00 by the next week in which that bowler returns to bowl. Everyone is responsible for his/her blind. This is the responsibility of the Captain to have your bowlers follow this rule. If the blind is not paid the following week, the bowlers score will not count and the bowler will not be permitted to bowl.

8. It is necessary to bowl at least 12 weeks or 36 games to qualify for individual and team money or awards.
9. Every bowler will get a 50 cent credit each week bowled toward the bowling dinner. Balance to be paid by bowler. The last 2 weeks are excluded.
10. If a bowler quits before the end of the season, it will be at the discretion of the Board of Directors if they should receive any money or awards of pin money.
11. The Secretary and Treasurer fees will be \$25.00 per team, with \$10.00 per team, (\$5.00 for the secretary and \$5.00 for the treasurer), to be collected at the beginning of each season and the remainder to be paid from the League account at the end of the bowling season.
12. We shall bowl thirty-two weeks, divided into four quarters. A \$25.00 award will be given to the winners of each quarter. A team may win more than one quarterly cash award, but can only represent only one quarter in the end of season roll-offs. The eighth week of each quarter shall be a "position night" whereby the No. 1 team shall bowl the No. 2 team, etc. according to the standings. If there is a tie in game points during "position night" or roll offs, total pins for that night will determine first, second, (etc) place winners. The week following the end of the regular bowling season, the first and second quarter winners and the third and fourth quarter winners will bowl to determine the first and second half winner's respectively. The following week the first and second half winners will bowl to determine the League Champions.
13. Championship and runner-up awards will be awarded. Individual monies will be awarded to winners of first, second and third place men and women for hi-game and hi-series actual and handicap. Individuals will receive only one award for either hi-game or hi-series with hi-series actual taking preference.
14. Handicap is 80%. No limit.

15. Anyone replacing or bringing a new bowler into the League after six weeks must have the approval of the Board of Directors.
16. The Vice-President automatically moves up to President of the following bowling season.
17. All Captains are to check the scores on the score sheet. Making sure that their team scores are all tallied and signed before leaving the lanes for the night. Captains are expected to transfer scores to sheets or assign a team member to do it.
18. The bowling banquet will be determined and announced by the Social team.
19. This rule will apply if we have an odd number of teams. The odd team shall bowl on two lanes. The team must bowl twenty five pins within their average per game and within seventy five pins total to win points.
20. Floaters may be used and you may bowl against your own team unless your team is bowling for first place on position night and cannot be used in roll-offs.
21. Prebowling is allowed, except during position rounds and roll-offs (and should be limited). If your whole team is prebowling, please contact the opposing team to let them know. A list of team captains' phone numbers will be provided.
